CRCHUQ is one of the largest hospital-based research centers in Canada, with some 240 researchers and 760 graduate students.

Recognized by Fonds de la recherche en santé du Québec (FRSQ) and affiliated with Université Laval, the Research Center is a component of Centre hospitalier universitaire de Québec (CHUQ), which provides specialized and ultra-specialized care to patients in the vast region of eastern Québec.

Research activities are oriented as much as possible to dovetail with CHUQ's clinical specialties as well as its teaching responsibilities in eight areas (cancer; endocrinology and genomics; infectiology and immunology; metabolism, vascular and renal health; neuroscience, reproduction and perinatal and children's health, population and environmental health, and knowledge transfer and evaluation of health technology and intervention methods). Over 1,800 people, scientists, research professionals, technicians, students, and postdoctoral interns work together to contribute to the development of our Research Center in a vibrant and ultra-modern environment.

The director of CRCHUQ is a high-level scientist known in Canada and around the world for his or her remarkable achievements in the area of health research. The candidate has excellent knowledge of the university environment in the field of health and health research. The candidate exhibits strong leadership and is recognized for his or her foresight and sense of entrepreneurship and partnership.

Reporting to the assistant director general of medical and university affairs and working in partnership with the executive board, the director is responsible for the operational implementation, tracking, and ongoing development of the strategic research plan. He or she is also accountable to the hospital board of directors and to FRSQ for budget management, and particularly the FRSQ grant.

The director's main duties include the following:

1. CRCHUQ strategic directions
2. Promotion and development of basic, clinical, epidemiological, and evaluative research in each of the organization's main fields
3. CRCHUQ human, financial, material, and IT resource management
4. Recruitment
5. Partnership development
6. Funding and revenue source development

In light of his or her responsibilities, the director is expected to

- Maintain a vibrant atmosphere of growth at CRCHUQ and optimize resources
- Take part in shaping the affiliation contract with Université Laval
- Act as CRCHUQ spokesperson and ambassador, as needed
- Help ensure successful partnerships

The director of CRCHUQ is appointed for a renewable, four-year term.

To carry out his or her mission, the selected candidate must possess solid scientific and administrative skills as well as good interpersonal skills in order to fulfill his or her role as facilitator.
